

## **AMOROLFINE**

### Indications/Uses

Listed in Dosage.

### Dosage/Direction for Use

Adult: Topical Nail fungal infections As 5% lacquer: Paint onto the affected nail 1-2 times/week. Continue for approx 6-12 months. Skin fungal infections As 0.25% cream: Apply once daily for at least 2-3 weeks. Continue for 3-5 days after cure is attained.

### Special Precautions

Childn. Pregnancy and lactation. Patient Counselling Avoid contact w/ eyes, ears, mucous membranes, and surrounding areas around the nail. Avoid using cosmetic lacquer or artificial nails.

### Adverse Reactions

Hypersensitivity reactions, skin irritation, erythema, pruritus, contact dermatitis, urticaria, blister. Rarely, burning sensation, severe skin reactions, nail disorder (e.g. nail discolouration, onychoclasia, onychorrhexis).
