

Betamethasone combination

INDICATION:

Skin disorders: atopic dermatitis, polymorphic eruptions

DOSAGE: Apply cream containing Betamethasone Valerate 0.12% + Clioquinol 3% into affected area

SAFETY ALERT:

Adverse Drug Reactions: Dermal atrophy, local irritation, folliculitis, hypertrichosis, dermal atrophy, telangiectasia, striae, easy bruising, hypopigmentation, delayed wound healing, fungal and bacterial skin infections

Contraindications:

1. Hypersensitivity
2. Rosacea, acne vulgaris, perioral dermatitis, perianal and genital dermatitis and primary cutaneous viral infections
3. Primary fungal or bacterial skin lesions; primary or secondary infections due to yeast; or secondary infections due to Pseudomonas or Proteus species

Drug interactions:

Significant systemic absorption – neomycin sulphate may increase the respiratory depressant effect of neuromuscular blockers
