

THEOPHYLLINE, EPHEDRINE, AND HYDROXYZINE b (Systemic)

Indications

Unaccepted

Theophylline, ephedrine, and hydroxyzine combination is used to control bronchospastic disorders; however, the efficacy of this combination medication in these disorders has not been established. 1 Although the FDA has proposed withdrawal of approval of new drug applications (NDAs) for fixed combinations containing theophylline, ephedrine, and hydroxyzine, these products remain on the market pending further review.
